In his book, "The Five Dysfunctions of a Team" Patrick Lencioni introduces us to the idea that trust is the foundation for optimum team performance. Lencioni's definition of trust focuses on vulnerability-based trust which can be challenging in the workplace when interacting with patients, colleagues, and teams.
