Description

Neonate babies are a special population that require a calm and systematic approach to assessment and care. By using the STABLE assessment platform, you will have improved comfort in these situations. Identifying when and how to request a NICU transport team can be confusing. This presentation will help clarify Level iii and Level ii NICU capabilities and how a NICU transport team can help you. This program will cover what to do with neonate babies when they unexpectedly arrive at your facility.

Key Learning Objectives:

- Support the neonatal patient in an appropriate manner until the transport team arrives
- Recognize the signs or indications that neonatal transport is necessary for a neonatal patient
- Initiate the referral process for neonatal transport
